"Evaluating process quality in schools" Braunschweig, Germany, 3rd – 4th September 2013

Dear SICI colleagues,

we are delighted to invite you to take part in the SICI workshop "Evaluating process quality in schools", held by the Lower Saxony Institute for Quality Development in Schools (NLQ), Germany.

Based on the Lower Saxon quality framework, the Lower Saxon inspection in the past mainly focussed on the accomplishment of the inspected quality items and selected concepts. For the newly designed inspection system (piloted until summer) core tasks within the framework were identified and defined to describe processes, which are most relevant for increasing the quality of teaching and learning. With the new instruments and procedures we inspect not only the quality of teaching but additionally the quality of these processes.

We hope you consider this challenging topic "Evaluating process quality in schools" relevant for your future inspection-work and invite you to participate in the workshop. This will offer one further great opportunity to cooperate on both the national and the international level.

Reservation and Communication

- 1. Contact the hotel directly to reserve your rooms for the night of the 3rd September (or earlier if you wish to arrive earlier). You can also extend your visit for a few more days. The price for the hotel room stays the same. **EC-members**: Please book an additional night and write an e-mail to Mrs Adlkofer or Mrs Thumann.
- 2. Please send your filled-in registration-form and the confirmation of your hotel booking to sabine.adlkofer@nlq.niedersachsen.de and copy to anke.thumann@nlq.niedersachsen.de no later than 25th June 2013.
- 3. Decide how you wish to travel (see below) and book the flights Hanover Airport is approximately one hour away from the venue, Berlin Airport approx. two hours, Hamburg Airport approx. three hours. Braunschweig Main Station is at three km distance from the hotel.
- 4. Braunschweig has a beautiful and historic venue in the centre of the city, which is at a distance of approx. 6 km from the hotel. There are various optional activities including a possible tour around town (see programme).

Expenses (Please note that all costs are given in €uro)

Ways of travelling to Braunschweig

By public transport

Braunschweig, the second biggest town in Lower Saxony, is situated between Hannover and Berlin in the north of Germany. It has got an airport but there is no public transport line offered.

So a comfortable option to arrive at Braunschweig is a flight to either Hanover, Berlin or Hamburg, then take a tram or bus to the central station and from there a train to Braunschweig central station (journey time between one or two hours). Timetables can be seen and tickets be bought at http://www.bahn.de/i/view/GBR/en/index.shtml. From Braunschweig central station take bus M 411 or M 11 direction Mascherode. Get off at the bus stop "Staatliche Untersuchungsämter". After 50 metres you will see the hotel on the right side.

By Car

Coming from the North on the A 2: At the motorway junction Braunschweig-Nord, take the A 391 towards Kassel/Salzgitter. At the interchange Braunschweig-Südwest take the A 39 towards Wolfenbüttel/Bad Harzburg and exit at Braunschweig-Südwest. At the traffic lights turn right into Salzdahlumer Straße. After 500 metres you will see the hotel on the right side.

Coming from the South on the A 7: At the motorway junction Salzgitter/Derneburg take the A 39 towards Salzgitter/Braunschweig. At the interchange Braunschweig-Südwest choose direction Wolfenbüttel/Bad Harzburg and exit at Braunschweig-Südwest. At the traffic lights turn right into Salzdahlumer Straße. After 500 metres you will see the hotel on the right side.
