WHAT DO WE FIND IMPORTANT?

- Training programm new inspectors (5 month 2 years).
- Structural developing knowledge and skills of inspectors
- Teamwork and collaboration (always 2 inspectors, consideration, intervision, peer-to-peer).
- Evidence gathering.
- Triangulation.
- Feedback of others, not involved in the inspection (external/internal, during/after the inspection).

WHAT DO WE FIND IMPORTANT?

- Transparancy of our process, before and during the process.
- Reflection on data of the last inspections.
- ISO certification.

QUALITY ASSURANCE

- It is not only Plan-Do-Check-Act.
- Impact inspectorate on and for others means: Quality Assurance for process, judgements, reports and conduct.
- But on what level?
 - Different inspectors.
 - Different school situations and development.
 - Different context.
- Most important outcome: we must have impact on the quality of education.

A FEW STATEMENTS

- Insuring through simplification of procedures.
- Building collaboration and consensus.
- Meaningful, intended to improvement.
- A culture that inspectors support and challenge their colleagues through respectful professional engagements around the quality of inspections.
- Quality Assurance is based on quality culture.
