Conference accommodation and Travel arrangements

The SICI general Assembly 2022 will take place in Dunboyne Castle Hotel & Spa on 17th and 18th November.

The venue can accommodate all attendees. The conference accommodation rate is available **only** until **17th October** so early booking is advised. You should quote "Department of Education" when making your booking.

We have negotiated a conference rate of €145.00 per single room, per night (inclusive of tax and Full Irish Breakfast) with the conference venue, the Dunboyne Castle Hotel for accommodation on **Wednesday 16th November** and on **Thursday 17th November**. We have also secured the conference rate for a limited number of rooms for the night of 15th November and these will be offered on a first come first served basis.

Airport-venue transfer options

Taxi: The journey should take about 22 minutes with a cost of €40-€50

Bus: There is no direct bus link from Dublin airport to Dunboyne. However, there are bus services ([Dublin Express](#) or [Aircoach](#)) available outside the departure exit that depart from Dublin Airport to the city centre. You can take the [70 bus](#) to Dunboyne from the city centre. The journey, including transfers, takes approximately 1h 55m and costs €12.

For those wishing to visit Dublin during their stay in Dunboyne, the number [70 bus](#) leaves Dunboyne from Stop 3333 in Dunboyne village to the city centre regularly from 6.30am to 11:30pm daily.
