Dublin, Ireland - 23 and 24 September 2019

On behalf of the Standing International Conference of Inspectorates and the Inspectorate, Department of Education and Skills, Ireland, we would like to invite you to attend the workshop organised in Dublin on 23 and 24 September 2019.

The topic of the workshop - “**Embedding innovative inspection practice**”, proposed as part of the SICI theme for 2019, Innovation in Inspection, will explore the following:

- how innovative inspection practices can support change and improvement in education systems in a changing education landscape
- how innovative inspection practice can be embedded and achieve the right balance between control and support of schools and teachers
- how to assess the impact of innovative inspection practice

Speakers and inspectors from Ireland and other countries will present on the topic. Participants will have the opportunity to discuss in small groups and with presenters effective ways to encourage and embed innovation in external evaluation.
